- Founded by the Wayne Regional Arts Council
- Held annually on the weekend of the second Saturday in July
- The first Chicken Show was held in 1981.
- The theme of "chickens" was chosen because: 1) the potential for art materials; 2) most people have knowledge and familiarity with chickens; and 3) chickens can be considered with humor.
- The Chicken Show received the 1996 Nebraska Outstanding Tourism Award and was selected in 1999, along with four other community events in America, to be featured in the Library of Congress.
- Wayne Chicken Show 2005 was the winner of two Nebraska State Pinnacle Awards given by the Nebraska Festival and Events, Inc.
